Concept Note

"Man sees, he also talks. When he talks to others, he calls it communicating; when he talks to himself, he calls it thinking. When he sees the world around him, he calls it reality; when he sees in his mind's eye, what is it? ... The moment of illumination is a visualizing experience—a dense, wordless, sensory experience."

This definition fits into the broader definition of the mind's eye being a process by which one is able to build a mental image. Imagery has been defined in various ways in literature and psychology. Sometimes it is used to refer to picture words, metaphors, similes, and descriptive language generally. At other times it refers to the mental pictures that we experience when we imagine the appearance of familiar places and friends. It is even used in the sense of unconscious imagery - the visual memories and workings of visual imagination that are not actively before the "mind's eye" but which move into view when required (Paivio 1983).

A number of brain scan studies have supported this view. When you look at a person up close, for example, a particular network of brain regions becomes active, including areas that process raw signals from your eyes as well as more sophisticated regions that recognize individual faces. When you close your eyes and conjure up a face, the parts of the brain that receive signals from the eyes are dormant, but the regions that recognize the features defining an individual again light up.
